Workshop modules will teach and provide injectable certification (to physicians and assistants) for the advanced techniques and protocols to properly treat acute and chronic musculoskeletal injuries and traumas to facilitate healing. We will cover differential diagnosis of chronic and acute disease processes and how they relate to joint and extremity injections and the appropriate treatment protocols to be used. Muscle response testing for prioritization of treatment protocols, needle placement, concentrations of therapies and quantities will be taught.

Areas covered in Module 1 hands-on workshop/class include but are not limited to:

- Rotator Cuff Injuries
- Arthritic and Degenerative Hips and Knees
- Plantar Fasciitis
- Carpal Tunnel Syndrome
- Heel Spurs
- Neuromas
- Tennis Elbow
- Sciatica
- Post-surgery
- Non-union fractures
- Scars
- Sports Injury

Also covered in Module 1:

- Proper protocol for assessing and administering Nutritional IVs
- IV Formulas to best address specific needs
- Proper safety measures
- Proper Prolo/Prolozone injectable protocols and techniques
- Proper exam, injectable protocols and techniques for intra-articular and trigger point injections for:
 1. upper extremities (shoulder, elbow, wrist, and hand)
 2. lower extremities (hip, knee, ankle, and foot)
- UBI and MAH protocol and procedures will be taught.

Module 1 is a prerequisite for Module 2.*

**If a physician has had previous injectable experience (minimum of three to six months office practice) and can demonstrate to Dr. Cullum their competence, they will be allowed to take Module 2 without Module 1, and test for certification.*

A note about Module 2:

This module is designed to take all practitioners who have been successfully treating different pain syndromes with nutritional Prolo/Prolozone injections to the next level. Module 2 builds on Module 1 and requires that a practitioner have several months of practice in their office using the techniques learned in Module 1. Injections in the following areas require extensive injection training and experience.

Areas covered in Workshop/Class Module 2 include but are not limited to:

- Hands-on demonstration for all injections
- Expanding on concepts and muscle response testing from Module 1
- Proper protocols and procedures for cervical, thoracic, lumbar, sacral, and pelvic intra-articular joint complex prolo/prolozone and trigger point injections
- Injections of the torso, anterior and posterior
- Injections of the head (sinuses, mouth, cranials, nose, eyes) and neck
- Frankenhauser pelvic injection
- P and O shot injections
- Prostate and erectile dysfunction Injections.

Workshop-size is limited to 20 physicians.
